Château de Béru, Chablis 2009 16

Drink 2012-2015

Phenolic notes, crunchy apple fruit. Dry, refined, conventional Chablis. (RH) 12.5%

Château de Béru, Chablis Premier Cru Montée de Tonnerre 2010 17

Drink 2012-2017

A modicum of oak influence on the nose. More recognisably Chablis than the Vaucoupin. Classically styled. Really ripe and beautiful fruit. (RH)

Château de Béru, Chablis Premier Cru Vaucoupin 2010 17

Drink 2012-2016

Interesting and phenolic with an oxidative orange peel note that might put some off. Complex, herbal and floral character on the nose. (RH)

Château de Béru, Chablis Grand Cru Blanchot 2010 17+

Drink 2012-2018

Fully lactic, creamy, oaked, spicy toffee character. Lacks the definition and minerality of the grandest Grand Crus, but is very impressive all the same. (RH)
